the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Oscar E. Brown & Margaret A. Brown, their heirs & assigns, forever:

ALL that parcel of land situated in Bates Township, Greenville County, and being more fully described, according to plat made by Terry T. Dill, May 23, 1963, as follows:

BEGINNING at an I. P. off center of County Road and running thence along County Road N. 17-49 E. 305 ft. to an I. P. at the corner of Whitmire land thence along Whitmire line N. 72-20 W. 714 ft. to an I. P.; thence S 17-49 W. 305 ft. to an I. P.; thence along Duncan line S. 72-20 E. 714 ft. to the point of beginning and containing five (5) acres.
