I, Mrs. Johnny Mann, now of Arlington, Virginia, formerly Margaret H. Campbell of Greenville County, South Carolina, having been informed that some question has arisen affecting the title of 34 acres of land located in Greenville County and formerly owned by Margaret H. Campbell in that a contract to sell and buy was entered into between Margaret H. Campbell, as Seller, and M. C. Moon, as Buyer, said contract being dated May 16, 1941, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County May 21, 1941, in Volume 233 at Page 226. Under the terms of the contract, the said M. C. Moon agreed to pay a certain amount as purchase price for said property and did pay down for said property the sum of \$80.00. That under the terms of the contract, the said M. C. Moon was to complete his part of the contract and pay the remaining part of the purchase price on or before ninety days from the date of said contract. That Margaret H. Campbell and M. C. Moon later agreed not to go through with the contract for sale. The said Margaret H. Campbell deeded three-fourths of an acre located near Augusta Road, Greenville County, to the said M. C. Moon in full settlement of the \$80.00 which the said M. C. Moon had paid on the contract for sale.

The said Margaret H. Campbell has since sold the property in question to B. F. Hicks.

Margaret H. Campbell, now Mrs. Johnny Mann, is informed and believes that M. C. Moon is now deceased and it has been in excess of twenty years since she had any interest in the property and, further, that the purpose of this Affidavit is to clear up any question as to the contract in question.
