IMPORTANT: If the deed is to be executed outside of South Carolina, the Grantor or Grantors must sign in presence of two (2) witnesses; both witnesses must sign; then one witness must go before a Natary Public who has a seal, or before the Clerk of a Court of record, and make and sign the affidavit or probate, the blank for which follows the deed; then the officer must sign and seal the jurat.

In the Renunciation of Dower, the wife's name (not the husband's) must be inserted in the blank, and she must sign her own name—as Mary Smith, not Mrs. John Smith; then the officer must sign and seal the certificate. If taken outside of South Carolina, it must be by a Notary or Clerk of Court of recard, with use of an impress seal.

If these directions be not strictly and literally followed, the deed will be valueless and cannot be recorded in South Carolina.

For deeds executed within the State, all these directions apply except that other officers can act and the impress seal is not essential.
