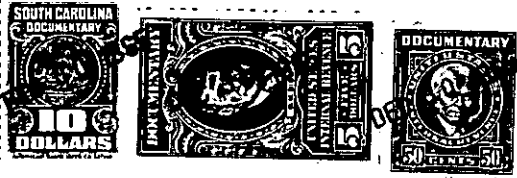

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in BUTLER Township, GREENVILLE

County, State of South Carolina containing 2.1 acres more or less, and being
 the northeast end part of the two adjoining tracts of land conveyed
 by T. P. Babb to J. D. Massey and surveyed by G. A. Ellis as per the
 plot shown on map 269-1 in the Block Book Department of Greenville
 County, with the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at the iron pin and big rock at the northeast corner
