RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT

COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 30th day of Localier, 1965, by and between Julia L. Wynn, Marie Wynn, Frances Wynn, Lucy Wynn Carter, Letha W. Jones, Thalia W. Henry Margie W. O'SHEAL REDDING, JAMES/WYNN, HEREMENARMEN, CHARLES WYNN, ROBERT WYNN, ROY WYNN and FRED WYNN, hereinafter called "Grantor" and DUKE POWER COMPANY, a North Carolina corporation, hereinafter called "Grantee",

WITNESSETH:

paid by Grantee, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does grant and convey unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, subject to the limitations hereinafter described, the right to erect, construct, reconstruct, replace, maintain and use towers, poles, wires, lines, cables, and all necessary and proper foundations, footings, crossarms and other appliances and fixtures for the purpose of transmitting electric power and for Grantee's communication purposes, together with a right of way, on, along and in all of the hereinafter described tracts of land lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

FIRST PARCEL: Being a strip of land 68 feet wide extending 34 feet on the northerly side and 34 feet on the southerly side of a survey line which has been marked on the ground and is approximately 1177.0 feet long and lies across the land of the Grantor (from Station 189+90.2 to Station 201+67.2).

SECOND PARCEL: BEGINNING at a point, said point being N 40-46 E 503.9 ft. from the intersection of the center line of White Horse Road and the center line of Old White Horse Road and runs thence with the southeasterly line of the W. E. Wynn property N 40-46 E 81.3 ft. to the existing
