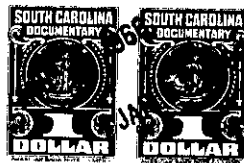

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release  
unto Bernard H. Brengard and Mary Brengard, their heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 112 as shown on a Plat of Section 2, Bellwood Estates, dated 1955 by Woodward Engineering Company, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, at Page 50, and having according to said plat, the following description, to-wit:

BEGINNING on Bellwood Road at an iron pin at joint front corners of lots 111 and 112 and running thence 80 feet with the line of said road to an iron pin at joint front corners of lots 112 and 113; running thence 204 feet with the side line of lot 113 to an iron pin at joint rear corners of lots 112 and 113; running thence 80 feet with the rear line of lot 112 to an iron pin at joint rear corners of lots 111 and 112; running thence 203.5 feet with the side line of lot 111 to the iron pin at joint front corners of lots 111 and 112 on Bellwood Road, the point of beginning.

NO residence shall be built on any lot costing less than \$7,500.00 ; no residence shall be built on said lots nearer than 25 feet to the front line; no outside toilets permitted and sewage to be disposed of by approved septic tanks.

THIS property is sold subject to rights of way of record.
