

Road N 55° 13' W 55.85 feet to an iron pin; thence S 34° 47' W 10 feet to an iron pin, thence N 55° 13' W 158 feet to a point on the southwest right-of-way line of Flat Shoals Road and the point of beginning of the parcel hereinafter described; thence S 34° 47' W a distance of 147.2 feet to a point; thence N 87° 04' W a distance of 48.15 feet to a point on the eastern side of Interstate Highway No. I-20; thence northerly along the eastern right-of-way line of Interstate Highway I-20 and following the curvature thereof 143.4 feet to a point; thence N 75° 54' E along said right-of-way line a distance of 62.05 feet to an iron pin on the southwest right-of-way line of Flat Shoals Road; thence S 55° 13' E along the southwest right-of-way line of Flat Shoals Road 69 feet to the point of beginning.

(Gordon Road)
