All of that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the West side of Briaroliff Drive (formerly Park Street) and on the East side of Overbrook Road, in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 3 and a portion of Lot No. 2 on plat of Tract No. 1 of the property of Overbrook Land Co., made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, June 1924, recorded in the R. M. C.
