KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Charles S. Bell

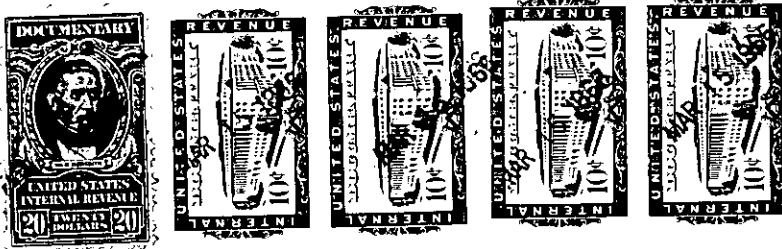
in consideration of Eighteen Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty (\$18,950.00)-----Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto James Calhoun Thomas & Judith James Thomas, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Butler Township, and being known and designated as a part of Lot No. #7 of a subdivision known as McSwain Gardens, with the Plat of that subdivision being recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, at page 75 and being more specifically shown according to said Plat as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Southeastern side of Mimosa Drive, at the joint front corner of Lot 6&7, and running thence S. 25-41 E. 147.3 feet to a point at the rear corner of Lot No. #6; thence S. 6-05 W. 45 feet to a point in the joint sideline of Lot 7 & 8; thence N. 77-55 W. 173.2 feet to a point on the Southeast side of Mimosa Drive, at joint front corner of Lot 7 & 8; thence with the Southeastern side of Mimosa Drive in 29-55 E. 85.9 feet to a point; thence continuing with the Southeastern side of Mimosa Drive N. 45-16 E. 95 feet to the point of beginning.
