of utilities, such as water, sewerage or electric power lines, along the street adjacent to said lots without compensation to the purchasers of the several lots.

These covenants are to run with the land, and shall be binding upon all persons owning any of said lots, during the period of their application. If the parties hereto, or any of them, their heirs or assigns, shall violate or attempt to violate any of the above covenants, it shall be lawful for any other person or persons owning any of said lots shown on the recorded plat to prosecute any proceedings at law against the person or persons violating or attempting to violate any such covenants, either to prevent himor them from so doing, or to recover damages for such violation.
