KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, BROADUS S. COLEMAN

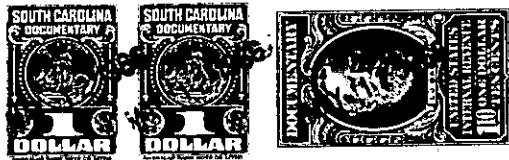
