and the assumption of mortgage set out below  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release  
unto Robert O. Willard and Joan H. Willard, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot #30 as shown on a plat of Oakwood Acres, prepared by J. Mac Richardson, dated September 1959, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book MM at Page 135, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Oakwood Avenue, the joint front corner of Lots #29 and #30, and running thence along the line of these lots, N. 35-38 W. 160 feet to an iron pin in the line of property now or formerly owned by John H. Wood; running thence S. 54-44 W. 95 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots #30 and #31; running thence S. 35-38 E. 160 feet to an iron pin on the northern edge of Oakwood Avenue; running thence along the northern edge of Oakwood Avenue, N. 54-22 E. 95 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning; being the same conveyed to us by J. P. Medlock by deed dated June 27, 1963, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 726 , at Page 185 .

This conveyance is made subject to restrictions recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 671, at Page 151, and to easements that may appear of record, on the recorded plat (s), or on the premises.

The grantees herein expressly assume and agree to pay the balance due on a certain note and mortgage executed by the grantors on June 27, 1963 in the original sum of \$ 14,850.00 in favor of First Federal Savings and Loan Association of Greenville, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 926, at Page 527, on which there is a balance due of \$ 13,864.04 as of this date.
