the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto M. D. BROOKSHIRE and JANET B. BROOKSHIRE, their heirs and assigns forever,

ALL that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all the improvements thereon, situate, lying, and being near Club View Heights, at the foot of Paris Mountain, in Greenville County, South Carolina, which contains one acre, more or less, which is a portion of Tract 8 of the Property of the H.W. Batson Estate, which is shown on a Plat recorded in Plats Book MM, Page 5D, and which is described more particularly according to a revision of that Plat dated March 1, 1966, by C.O. Riddle, R.L.S., as follows.

BEGINNING at an iron pin which is the western most point of Tract 8, and running thence N. 61-52 E. 249 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 28-08 E. 175 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 61-52 W. 249 feet to an iron pin; and, thence N. 28-08 W. 175 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
