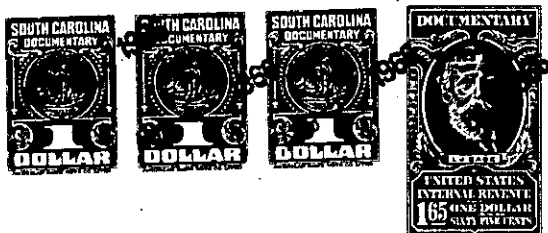

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That EUGENIA LINK, NOW KNOWN AS EUGENIA LINK MANSFIELD

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand, Five Hundred and No/100ths (\$1,500.00) Dollars-----

to in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said DORIS W. GAULT, her heirs and assigns:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land at the Northwestern point of intersection of Shamrock Lane (now or formerly also known as Cherry Street) and Linnet Drive (now or formerly also known as Link Street) in Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lots Nos. 1 and 15 on a plat entitled, "Property of T. T. Link" by W. D. McBrayer, dated May 24, 1937, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book D at Page 248 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Northwestern point of intersection of Shamrock Lane and Linnet Drive, and running thence with the Northern side of Linnet Drive N. 83-22 W. 334 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of a 30 foot alley, thence with the Northern side of said 30 foot alley N. 6-38 E. 60 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 83-22 E. 334 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Shamrock Lane, thence with the Western of Shamrock Lane S. 6-38 W. 60 feet to the point of beginning.

The above described property is a portion of that property conveyed to T. T. Link by deed of Edith G. Coyle, dated November 15, 1932, and recorded that same date in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 115 at Page 254. T. T. Link subsequently died intestate on November 30, 1942, living as his sole heirs at law his widow, Ella Link, and his two children, Eugenia Link, the grantor herein, and Thomas D. Link, reference being made to his estate filed in the Probate Court for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Apt. 460 at File 16. Thomas D. Link and Ella T. Link subsequently conveyed all their right, title and interest in and to the above described property to the grantor herein by deed dated April 11, 1944, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County on April 13, 1944, in Deed Volume 262 at Page 401.
