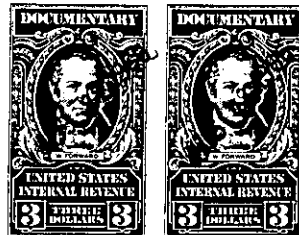

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by FRANK DILL and HATTIE DILL, his wife,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Frank Dill and Hattie Dill, their heirs and assigns, forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about two miles west of the Town of Landrum, South Carolina on the Belue Mill Road in Greenville County and described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the said Belue Mill Road and running North 34 deg. 30 min. West 440 feet to an iron pin; thence North 26 deg. 30 min. East 200 feet to an iron pin; thence South 37 deg. 30 min. East 440 feet to the Belue Mill Road; thence with said road South 23 deg.
