ALL of that tract of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as a portion of the property on Plat Book Q, page 21 and being situate between Wedgewood Drive and Cool Springs Drive and Rutherford (Camp) Road and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwestern side of Rutherford Road at the corner of Lot No. 42 of North Meadow Heights, shown in Plat Book W, page 183 and being 165.3 feet Southwest of the curved intersection of Cool Springs Drive and running thence N 51-43 W 401.75 feet to an iron pin in a branch; thence following a traverse line, with the creek as the line, which traverse line is set eastward of the creek, the following courses and distances, to-wit: N 5-33 W 117.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N 5-33 W 62 feet to an iron pin; thence N 24-08 E 75.4 feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence N 9-42 W 40.6 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Wedgewood Drive and running thence in a South-westerly direction along said Drive 125 feet, more or less , to Lot No. 46 of Croftstone Acres, shown in Plat Book S, page 78; and running thence S 1-16 E 295.2 feet, more or less, to an iron pin in the rear of Lot No. 48; thence along property now or formerly of J.J.
