ALL that lot of land in the county of Greenville, state of South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 23 and the southern half of Lot No. 24, on plat of Glendale Heights subdivision recorded in plat book KK, page 143 of the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., and having according to said plat and a recent survey made by R. K. Campbell, Engineer, November 1965, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Glendale Street, the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 22 & 23, and running thence with the east side of said Street N. 6-45 W. 105 feet to an iron pin; thence through the middle of Lot No. 24, N. 83-15 E. 130 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of said lot; thence S. 6-45 E. 105 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot No. 22; thence with the line of said lot S. 83-15 W. 130 feet to the beginning corner.
