KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that WOODSIDE MILLS, a corporation organized and existing under the by virtue of the laws of South Carolina, hereinafter referred to as Grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable considerations, in hand paid by DUKE POWER COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of North Carolina, hereinafter referred to as Grantee, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer, and deliver unto the said Duke Power Company, its successors and assigns, the following described property, easements, rights and privileges, to-wit:

(1) The following personal property:

(a) The street lighting system of the Grantor located in and serving the mill village near the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, known as the Greenville Plant Mill Village, owned by the Grantor, including one hundred sixty (160) fixtures, one hundred forty (140) poles, one thousand, six hundred eighty five (1,685) feet of No. 8 copper wire and other necessary fixtures and attachments.

(2) The right, privilege and easement to go in and upon the land, streets, alleys, and ways within the area of the mill village known as Greenville Plant Mill Village of the Grantor, and to maintain, use and operate the said street lighting circuits as the same are now located and installed, or as the same may be reconstructed, extended or relocated, and to construct, maintain and operate extensions or relocations of any of said lines along the streets, ways and alleys of said mill village, the area of said village being shown on print dated July 8, 1966, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof; together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said
