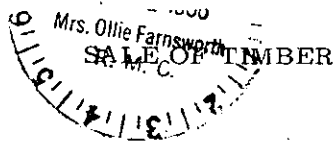

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Mitchell Lumber Company, Inc., of the County and State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven Thousand and no/100 (\$11,000.00) Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto Continental Can Company, Inc., its Successors and Assigns:

All merchantable trees and timber now standing on the tract of land containing 127 acres, more or less, except the merchantable saw poplar, situated on the Jones Mill Road and on North Durban Creek, in Greenville and Laurens Counties, State of South Carolina, bounded by lands of Fannie Cooper, Mattie Jones, Florence Cooper Abbott, and others, and being shown as No. 552.1-1-10 on the Greenville County Block Book Mpa, and being the same conveyed to Robert L. Smith by deed of Martha G. Cathcart as Executrix of the will of Robbie Godfrey.

The said Continental Can Company, Inc., its employees, agents, or assigns, shall have the full right and privilege of entering upon the said tract of land at convenient places for the purpose of cutting, sawing and removing said timber or lumber according to custom, at anytime within eighteen (18) months from this date.

It is agreed that the said Continental Can Company, Inc., its employees, agents or assigns, shall exercise reasonable care in protecting the smaller trees not sold hereby.

The said Mitchell Lumber Company, Inc., hereby warrant good title for said timber unto the said Continental Can Company, Inc., and its successors and assigns, and binds itself, its successors and assigns to warrant and defend the aforesaid timber conveyance unto the said Continental Can Company, Inc., according to the terms of this sale.
