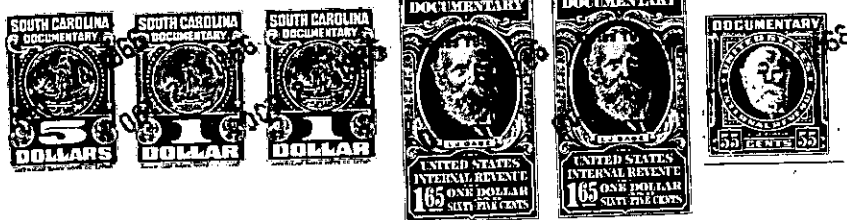
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that We, Allen E. Vaughn and William A. Vaughn,
