Brown, Barbara Scoggins and Otis Ginn, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, love and affection, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto CHARLES E. MACHEN, his heirs and assigns, forever, all our right, title and interest in and to the following described real estate, to wit:

ALL that lot of land with improvements on the Western side of Bailey Street near the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 240 on plat of McCary Tract, made by W. A. Hudson on April 15, 1905, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book A, at page 279, having the following metes and bounds according to said plat, to wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Western side of Bailey Street at the corner of Lot No. 241, and running thence N. 76-15 W. 150 feet to a stake; thence with the line of Lot No. 245, S. 13-45 W. 66 feet to a stake; thence with the line of Lot No. 239, S-76-15 E. 150 feet to a stake on Bailey Street; thence with the Western side of Bailey Street, N. 13-45 E. 66 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described property is the same conveyed to Charlie E. Machen and Mary G. Machen by deed of B. F. Burgess, dated August 7, 1950, and recorded in the RMC Office for said county and state in Deed Book 415, at page 529.
