All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, Tax District 500, being known and designated as the greater portion of Lot No. 25 and a small portion of Lot No. 24 of a subdivision known as Forest Heights as shown on a plat thereof made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in June, 1946 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book P, at Page 71, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Said property is the same conveyed to Charles W. Scales and Jennie S. Scales by Charles W. Scales, Jr. and Hazel L. Scales by deed dated September 15, 1959 and recorded in the R. M. C.
