

5. The death during my lifetime of both of the beneficiaries designated hereunder shall revoke such designation, and in such event, I reserve the right to designate a new beneficiary. Should I for any reason fail to designate such new beneficiary, this trust shall terminate upon my death and the trust property shall revert to my estate.

6. In the event of my death or legal incapacity, I hereby nominate and appoint as Successor Trustee hereunder the Primary Beneficiary and if such Primary Beneficiary shall be deceased or upon his or her failure or ceasing to act, then I nominate and appoint as Successor Trustee the Contingent Beneficiary, and upon his or her failure or ceasing to act or should I for any reason fail to designate the person above intended to be nominated, then I nominate and appoint as such Successor Trustee hereunder whosoever shall qualify as executor, administrator or guardian, as the case may be, of my estate.

7. This Declaration of Trust shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns of the undersigned and upon the Successors to the Trustee.

8. The Trustee and his successors shall serve without bond.

9. This Declaration of Trust shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of South Carolina
