C., the receipt whereof being hereby acknowledged, (I) (we) hereby grant unto said City of Greenville, a right-of-way or easement along, over or under (my) (our) property for the purpose of: Installing and maintaining sanitary sewer lines with one manhole, said right-of-way to extend 15 feet on each side of the center line during construction and a permanent right-of-way of five feet on each side of the center line of said sewer line as installed, and being 200 feet, more or less, in length.

Together with the right of ingress and egress for the purpose of inspecting and maintaining the same.

Said property is described as follows: Located in the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 410 on a plat of Section D of Gower Estates, recorded in Plat Book RR at pages 192 & 193, being situate on the Western side of Pimlico Court.
