IV. ENFORCEMENT

Enforcement shall be by proceedings at law or in equity against any person or persons violating or attempting to violate any covenant either to restrain violation or to recover damages.

V. SEVERABILITY

Invalidation of any one of these covenants by judgment or Court Order shall in no wise affect any of the other provisions which shall remain in full force and effect.

VI. PROPERTY COVERED.

The foregoing restrictive covenants apply to all of the subdivision shown on the Plat of the Property of William Maxwell, made by C. O. Riddle, R.L.S., which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQQ at page 37.
