GEORGIA, FULTON COUNTY
TO THE SUPERIOR COURT OF SAID COUNTY

The petition of Johnnie M. Smith, Carrol Campbell
and Grady Anderson, all of whom reside at the same address,
said address being 97 Leslie Street, S. E., Atlanta 17, Georgia,
respectfully shows to the Court;

I

Petitioners desire to form a corporation to be known as
EVANGELISTIC TEMPLES, INC.

The period of existence to be thirty-five (35) years
with the right of renewal thereafter as provided by law, with its
principal office located in Fulton County, Georgia.

II

The said corporation shall be organized and operated
exclusively for religious, charitable, recreational, and/or edu-
cational purposes, and no part of the net earnings of which inures
to the benefit of any incorporator or of any individual, no sub-
stantial part of the activities of which is carrying on propaganda
or otherwise attempting to influence legislation.

III

The corporation shall have no capital stock, and no
incorporator and no trustee or any other individuals shall at any
time have any interest in the earnings or income of the corporation;
and no dividend or returns of any character nor any part of the
assets of the corporation shall ever be returned to any incorporator
or to any trustee thereof, either upon dissolution or otherwise.

IV

The governing authority of the corporation shall vest in
the spiritual head of the corporation, who shall, acting for and
in behalf of the corporation, exercise and execute the powers herein
given and enumerated below. The manner and mode of operation shall
be as are outlined in the by-laws. The office of spiritual head of
the corporation, to be held by Johnnie M. Smith, petitioner, shall
be of perpetual duration, provided, however, that the same duration
