

Street and being more fully shown on the plat attached hereto marked Exhibit I and shown as Parcel A on said plat and also more fully shown on South Carolina Highway Department drawings of Pendleton Street as docket number 23.540, U. S. Highway 123, project U-2627(2), part 2, particularly pages 26 and 28 adjacent to tracks 75 and 76. The Prevosts have agreed to pay to the City of Greenville for its right, title and interest in Willis Street the sum of Six Hundred Fifty (\$650.00) Dollars.

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This matter comes before the Court for an approval of this transfer of Willis Street to Mrs. Prevost as part of the settlement in this litigated matter. In reviewing the matter, there is no question that it is to the public interest for this street to be abandoned as both the South Carolina Highway Department and the City of Greenville feel that it is not only unnecessary to keep this street open but would be a detriment both to safety and unnecessary costs. With this street being abandoned Mrs. Prevost owns all the land adjacent to it other than the land across Willis Street that was purchased in fee simple by the South Carolina Highway Department. Of course, it is elementary in the case of abandonment of a street that each adjacent landowner is entitled to take to the middle of the said street. In this matter, the South Carolina Highway Department, if it has rights in this street by reason of being an adjacent owner or for any other reason, does hereby expressly consent to transferring all of its right, title and interest in and to this street to Mrs. Grace Steele Prevost.
