HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto
the said W. R. Hipp

All that certain lot of land situated in Chick Springs Township,
County and State aforesaid, being known and designated as Lot No. 24
on Roscoe Drive, in what is known as Lake View Heights, property of
Mrs. Bessie and I. M. Wood Estate, as shown on a subdivision and
plat of same made by H. S. Brockman, Reg. Surveyor, dated November
2, 1959, said plat being of record in the R. M. C. Office for
Greenville County in Plat Book RR, page 19.

The above lot is hereby conveyed subject to the Protective
Covenants applicable to all the lots in this subdivision known as
Lake View Heights, near Greer, S. C., which are of record in the
