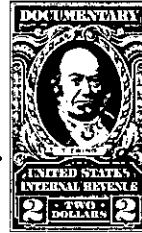

paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by James C. Jeter and Henry E. Jeter of
Greenville, S. C. in the State aforesaid Greenwood County

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said. James C. Jeter and Henry E. Jeter, their heirs and
assigns forever, the following described real estate, to wit:

All that lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being on Westfield Street,
City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:
Beginning at a corner of the Shuman property on Westfield Street and
running back 217 feet to a stake on Gower or Martin Street; thence with
Gower Street, or Martin Street, in a northerly direction and parallel
with Westfield Street 55 feet to a stake on Gower or Martin Street;
thence in an easterly direction 217 feet to a stake on Westfield Street
thence with Westfield Street in a southerly direction 55 feet to the
beginning corner, and being the identical lot conveyed to William A. Moore
by R. J. Cartledge, Judge of Probate of Greenwood County, South Carolina,
by deed dated November 26, 1935 and recorded in the office of Register of
Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Book 183 at Page 212.
