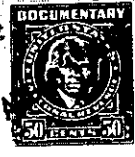

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release  
unto  
Eugenia S. and Robert Lee Thornton, their heirs and assigns:

ALL that certain lot of land lying at the intersection of Andrews Lane and Georgia Street, Town of Fountain Inn, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and shown on a plat of property of J. C. Drummond by C. O. Riddle, dated May, 1967, which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in plat book RRR, page 131, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Georgia Street, near the intersection of Andrews Lane and running thence with the side of said Georgia Street, N. 54-27 E., 94.9 ft. to an iron pin; thence with other property of the Grantor, S. 37-25 E., 138.4 ft. to an iron pin; thence S. 35-07 W., 45 ft. to an iron pin on the northeastern side of Andrews Lane; thence with the side of said Lane, N. 58-00 W., 100 ft. to an iron pin and N. 52-36 W., 63.6 ft. to an iron pin at the point of beginning.
