

(d) All markers, footmarkers, or headmarkers, two feet or less, shall be flush with the ground.

7. All work in connection with the preparation of monument bases and the placing of monuments shall be completed without delay, and when the work is finished all waste material must be removed and all reasonable precaution must be taken to protect the grounds, grass, flowers, curb, paving, other monuments, and all other property from damage or injury while the work is being done.

8. No coping, fence, or other kind of enclosure, shall be placed on any lot or grave site.

9. All workers performing any work or service in the cemetery shall work under the direction of the Superintendent, and anyone failing to abide by his instructions, or violating any of the rules and regulations herein stated, shall not be permitted to work in said cemetery at any time in the future.

10. Upon the payment of the purchase price of any lot or burial site, the Superintendent will deliver to such person a deed conveying the property to such purchaser or purchasers.

11. If the purchaser of any one or more of said grave sites shall become in default for a period of sixty days in the payment of any sums agreed upon, all such sums previously paid shall be forfeited to the owners, and the owners will thereafter be authorized to re-sell said lot or lots, free from any claim of the defaulting purchaser.

12. All lots may be re-sold from time to time, provided they have been fully paid for, but the seller of said lots shall notify the Superintendent of such re-sale in writing.

13. No advertising of any kind shall be permitted at any place within the area as shown on the above referred to plat.

14. The property shown on plat recorded in Plat Book 000 at page 165, RMC Office, is owned by Alvin L. Huff and Patrick R. Howell, who constitute the partnership under the name of Calvary Memorial Gardens.
