All that lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, shown as Lot 26, Block D, on plat of S. Slater and Sons, Inc., made by J. E. Serrine and Company, dated July 10th, 1940, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "K" at pages 63, 64, and 65, which lot is situate on the eastern side of Webster Street in the Village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Webster Street, joint corner of Lots 26 and 27, Block D, said pin also being 425 feet north from the northeast corner of the intersection of Webster Street and Edison Street, and running thence with the line of Lot 27, N. 87-26 E., 125 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lot 7, N. 2-34 W. 75 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 25 S. 87-26 W. 125 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Webster Street; thence with the eastern side of Webster Street S. 2-34 E. 75 feet to the point of beginning.
