Hill, and Eunice M. Hill, their heirs and assigns forever on the following described property:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the Northwesterly side of Walnut Street, in subdivision known as "Overbrook" in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being shown as portion of lots No. 28 and No. 28-A on plat of property of Smith and Goddard, prepared by Furman and Cureton, August 21, 1920, and having according to a recent plat and survey of property of Alvin J.
