RELEASE AGREEMENT



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT Sun Oil Company, a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of New Jersey, for and in consideration of the premises and for the sum of ONE HUNDRED AND TWO AND NO/100 (\$102.00) Dollars, to it in hand paid by THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant unto the said THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon the tract of land containing approximately 1.4 acres more or less, situated in Butler Township, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, bounded by lands of:

J. H. Cochrane, Pelham Road (S 23-492); and the right of way of Interstate Highway I-85; the property affected by this right of way is the same property conveyed to Sun Oil Company by Deed of W. R. DeLoache, et al, dated January 7, 1966 and recorded in the Greenville County RMC Office in Deed Book 792, page 51.

and to construct and maintain in, upon and through said premises, in a proper manner, a pipe line, and other necessary apparatus incident thereto, using the necessary appliances and machinery for such work for the purpose of conveying water through the premises above described, together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said pipe line all with the right to cut away and keep clear of said pipe line all trees and other obstructions that may in any way endanger or interfere with the proper operation of or access to the same.

It is understood and agreed that the right of way to be used under this contract during construction is to be 50 feet in width throughout the entire length which is approximately 102 feet, and the damage, which THE CITY OF CREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA is to be liable for during construction, is to be confined to this strip and nothing beyond. The location of the pipe line when laid, will determine the definite location of the right of way. The location of said pipe line is to be approximately along the line as now located and staked out by the engineers, subject to a variation of not exceeding five feet either way. The permanent right of way, after the pipe line is installed, shall be 20 feet in width measuring 10 feet from the center on each side of said pipe line as laid and no obstruction shall hereafter be placed on said 20 foot right of way. The right of way is shown on a drawing dated October, 1957, labeled 'Water Line Right of Way, Sun Oll Company to the City of Greenville, South Carolina' which is attached here to and made a part of this conveyance.

It is further understood that the Grantor is to have the right to use this right of way strip of land provided such use
