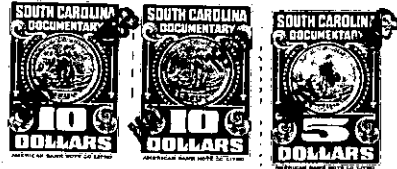

All that lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 24.5 acres more or less, being part of deed to us by Vol. 257, Page 226:

BEGINNING on a nail in Butter Street (S. C. Highway) about 2 1/2 miles South of Tryon, North Carolina, running thence with same South 53-20 East 300 feet South 37 - 14 East 200 feet, South 23-30 East 441 feet; thence leaving Highway S. 60-30 West (passing an iron pin at 20 feet) 214 feet to a point in branch (iron pin reference at North 60-30 East 6 feet): thence down branch the line, South 3-21 East 235.2 feet) (Mapping line) to an iron pin in branch; thence South 60-30 West 1,000 feet to an old black gum; thence North 16-53 West 679 feet to old stone; thence North 16-53 West 679 feet to old stone; thence with Mayson North 36-11 East 1,168 feet to the BEGINNING (iron pin reference at South 36-11 15 feet).
