

District, that such lines, including the cost of installation, have been fully paid for, and that Pine Valley Builders, Inc. has the authority to convey such lines. Pine Valley Builders, Inc. further agrees to hold harmless Mauldin-Simpsonville-Fountain Inn Water District from any loss in connection with this conveyance.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said water lines, valves, fittings and accouterments to Mauldin-Simpsonville-Fountain Inn Water District, its successors and assigns forever.

Mauldin-Simpsonville-Fountain Inn Water District agrees to pay the sum of Four Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-nine and 10/100 Dollars (\$4,659.10) for such conveyance, such sum to be paid when the annual revenue to Mauldin-Simpsonville-Fountain Inn Water District from water sold through such lines equals or exceeds Four Hundred Sixty-five and 91/100 Dollars (\$465.91).
