C., the receipt whereof being hereby acknowledged, (I) (we) hereby grant unto said Town of Simpsonville, a right-of-way or easement along, over or under (my) (our) property for the purpose of installing and maintaining a sanitary sewer line, said right-of-way to extend 20 feet on each side of the center line during the construction and a permanent right-of-way of ~~12 feet~~ 12 feet, 6 inches on each side of the center line of said sewer line as installed and being 190 feet, more or less, in length. There is one manhole on this lot.

Together with the right of ingress and egress for the purpose of inspecting and maintaining the same.
