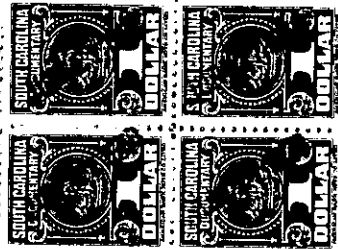

 of J. R. West, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, December, 1939,
