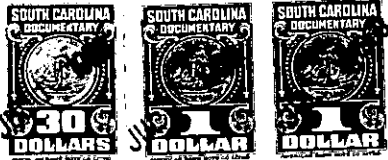
HUGH L. WATSON, HIS HEIRS AND ASSIGNS, FOREVER:
