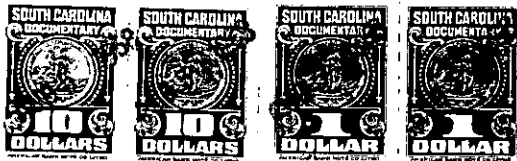
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that B. M. Meredith, Sr. -----
