to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee(s) Woodrow R. Vaughn and his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain parcel or lot of land situated on the west side of Taylor Road, near the City of Greer and northwestward therefrom, Oneal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Taylor Road, the joint front corner with Lot No. 2 as shown on the following described plat and running thence with the common line of said lots N. 81-45 W. 197.9 feet (passing an iron pin at 14 feet and another iron pin at 135.5 feet) to an iron pin on the line of property now or formerly belonging to Lewis Vaughn; thence with his line, S. 5-42 W. 123.6 feet to an old iron pin; thence continuing with the line of Lewis Vaughn, S. 84-00 E. 197.1 feet to a nail in the Taylor Road (iron pin back on the line at 23 feet); thence with the Taylor Road, N. 5-55 E. 116 feet to the beginning corner; being shown and designated as Lot No. 1 on a plat of the property of Woodrow R. Vaughn and Robert M. Lowe, prepared by John A. Simmons, Registered Surveyor, dated August 2, 1968, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book YYY, page 117.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to Layverne K. Vaughn and Annie May Vaughn by deed from Troy Vaughn recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 499, page 137. The said Layverne K. Vaughn died testate May 28, 1967, devising his interest in the above described property to his wife, the grantor herein (see the Estate File of Layverne Kellow Vaughn recorded in the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 992, File 22).

This conveyance is made subject to all rights-of-way and easements of record, on recorded plats, and on the premises.

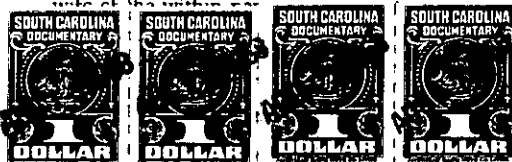
