KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Thomas Jackson Campbell, of Greenville County,

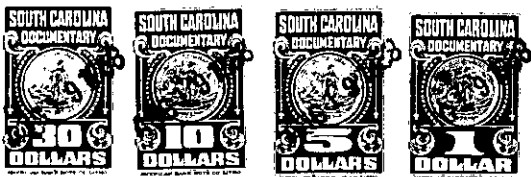
in consideration of Twenty-Three Thousand and No/100-----(\$ 23, 000. 00)----- Dollars,

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being shown as Lot # 8 of Oak Forest Subdivision; plat of which is recorded in Plat Book "CCC", Page 41, and according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
