the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Boyden L. Brown, Jr., his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 192, Section 4, of a subdivision known as Colonial Hills, as shown on a plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineers & Architects, dated October 20, 1967, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book WWW, at Page 3, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Heathwood Drive, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 191 and 192, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 13-45 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 75-50 E. 151.18 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Woodleigh Drive; thence with the western side of Woodleigh Drive, N. 21-30 W. 40 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said drive, N. 29-00 W. 88.1 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with Woodleigh Drive as it intersects with Heathwood Drive, N. 66-22 W. 39.7 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Heathwood Drive; thence with Heathwood Drive, S. 76-15 W. 91 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by Williams Land Company, Inc. by deed dated May 16, 1968, and recorded in the R.
