KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, William W. Radford, of the County and State aforesaid,

in consideration of One (\$1.00) Dollar, love and affection - - - - - Dollars -
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Alyce K. Radford, her heirs and assigns forever, an undivided one-half interest in and to the following described property, to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Butler Township, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as a portion of Lot No. 4, of Block B, of a subdivision known as "East Highlands", as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "K", at pages 35 and 36, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Highland Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 4 and 5, and running thence along Highland Drive, N. 23-43 E. 60 feet to a point in the line of Lot No. 4; thence running across Lot No. 4 in a Southeasterly direction approximately S. 64-32 E. approximately 270 feet to a pin in five-foot strip reserved for utilities, said pin being 7 feet South of the joint rear corner of Lots 3 and 4; thence S. 16-11 W. 51 feet to the joint rear corner of Lots 4 and 5; thence along the line of Lots 4 and 5, N. 68-15 W. 276.4 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to the grantor by deed from B.H. Trammell, dated May 14th, 1948, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Deed Book 347, at page 175.
