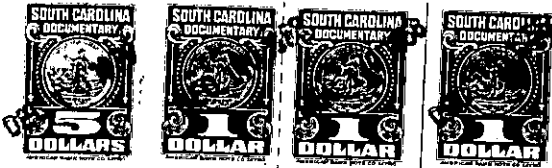

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeastern corner of Overton Avenue and Verner Drive and running thence with the eastern side of Overton Avenue, N. 19-13 E. 106.15 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot 17; thence with the line of said lot, S. 70-50 E. 175.35 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 19-11 W. 131.7 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Montis Drive; thence with the intersection of Verner Drive, S. 63-35 W. 40.6 feet to an iron pin on Verner Drive; thence with the northern side of said Drive, N. 59-24 W. 125 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Overton Avenue; thence with the curve of the intersection, the chord of which is N. 20-06 W. 38.7 feet to the beginning corner.

This lot is conveyed subject to restrictions recorded in Deed Book 800 at page 277 and to all other easements of record which affect said property.
