

through that certain strip of land being an extension of the westerly terminus of Lincoln Road running approximately 150 feet with a width of 50 feet, said extension lying and being along the northerly boundary of the tract hereinbefore conveyed by the grantors to the grantees, for use as a means of ingress, egress and regress to and from the aforesaid tract. It is understood and agreed that in the event the grantors, their heirs and assigns reserve the right to construct and build a road upon, over and across the said extension of Lincoln Road and in that event the easement herein granted shall be used in common with the grantors, their heirs and assigns.

It is further mutually understood and agreed that the easement herein granted shall be binding upon the grantors, their heirs and assigns.
