

the publicly owned storm sewer underneath Greenacre Road, as shown on the above referred recorded plat, after which it will cease and come to an end. It is agreed that if any public authority shall henceforth install a storm sewer in or under West Antrim Drive directly in front of Grantee's property, Grantee, at the request of Grantor and with the approval and consent of said public authority, shall at its expense connect to said storm sewer across its own land, whereupon this easement shall cease and terminate.

7. This easement shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the parties hereto, their successors and assigns.

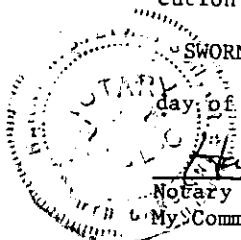
