

11. It is understood and agreed that the Town of Mauldin, has as its primary responsibility, to provide sewer service to the present and future incorporated limits of the Town. Therefore, the sewer service herein agreed to be furnished is limited to the excess capabilities of the sewer system over and above the requirements of the residents of the Town. The Town of Mauldin, acting on the advise of an engineer, shall have the right to refuse to permit any additional taps on to the sewer system if, in the opinion of the Town Council, such would or could result in the system not efficiently handling the present and anticipated requirement of the Town of Mauldin. No tap shall be permitted within the above described area except for domestic waste purposes only, without the written consent of the Town.

12. In addition to the other remedies for collection of the annual charge, the Town of Mauldin shall have the right to disconnect and discontinue sewer service to any user who fails to pay the annual charge as herein provided.

13. In the event the trunk lines and/or treatment facilities of the Town should ever be taken over or purchased by any organization, agency, district, or governmental body, then such shall not invalidate any of the provisions of this Agreement.
