

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That E. Burnham Ballou
of Laudrum S.C. #2

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of \$1000 00

one thousand dollars — Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents

by E. L. Ballou

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said E. L. Ballou

all that certain tract, parcel or lot of
land lying and being in Glassy mt.
Township and Greenville County and
being in the State of South Carolina
having the following - metes and bounds
and courses and distances.

Beginning on a stake on middle Tyger
river and running thence N 5 E 29.00 ch.
to a red oak. Thence S 79 1/2 E 9.00 ch. to a white oak
on the Branch. Thence down said branch to
the river the mouth of the branch. Thence
up said river to a stake the beginning
corner. The above description was taken from
a plat made by James K. Dickson April 24
1874 joined by lands of J. N. Brown and
others. Containing Twenty one acres (21.00)
more or less.
