KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, T. W. Stokes, of the County and State aforesaid,

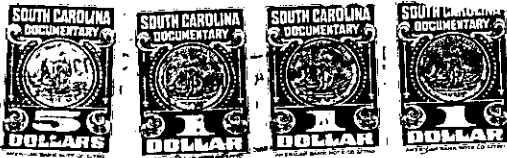
in consideration of Four Thousand (\$4,000.00) Dollars,
